Explosive Ordnance Risk Education (EORE): During the 4th quarter of 1398, in total 139,202 people received explosive ordnance risk education in 491 communities. Out of the given figure, 48.03% were female, 51.96% were male and 73.83% were children.

Workforce: The MAPA workforce for the 4th quarter of 1398 was 7,434 people, out of which 6,338 staff (84.90%) were part of the humanitarian organizations and 1,094 (15.10%) were part of commercial companies. Out of 49 national and international mine action organizations, 13 NGOs and 5 commercial companies were operational during the quarter.

Funding Status (1398 / 2020): The table below demonstrates funding target and budget which has been confirmed for the year 1398. Funding to the MAPA is channeled through the UNMAS-managed Voluntary Trust Fund (VTF) and bilaterally through donor contracts with implementing partners.
