Mine/ERW Risk Education: During the 3rd quarter of 1397, in total 182,415 people received mine/ERW risk education in 246 communities. Of this figure, 31.6% were female, 68.4% were male and 53.7% were children.

Workforce: The MAPA workforce for the 3rd quarter of 1397 was 7,921 people, out of which 6,873 staff (86.7%) were part of the humanitarian organizations and 1,048 (13.3%) were part of commercial companies. Out of 49 national and international mine action organizations, 10 NGOs and 3 commercial companies were operational during the quarter.

Funding Status (1397 / 2018): The table below demonstrates funding target and budget which has been confirmed for the year 1397. Funding to the MAPA is channeled through the UNMAS-managed Voluntary Trust Fund (VTF) and bilaterally through donor contracts with implementing partners.
