QUARTERLY UPDATE

Mine/ERW Risk Education: During the 1st quarter of 1398, in total 253,050 people received mine/ERW risk education in 498 communities. Out of the given figure, 26.6% were female, 73.4% were male and 50.4% were children.

Workforce: The MAPA workforce for the 1st quarter of 1398 was 6,772 people, out of which 5,720 staff (84.4%) were part of the humanitarian organizations and 1,052 (15.6%) were part of commercial companies. Out of 49 national and international mine action organizations, 11 NGOs and 2 commercial companies were operational during the quarter.

Funding Status (1398 / 2019): The table below demonstrates funding target and budget which has been confirmed for the year 1398. Funding to the MAPA is channeled through the UNMAS-managed Voluntary Trust Fund (VTF) and bilater-

ally through donor contracts with implementing partners.
